WORD

Exodus 3:11-12 (NIV)

11 But Moses said to God, "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?" 12 And God said, "I will be with you. And this will be the sign to you that it is I who have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you [b] will worship God on this mountain."

As we continue our series Nerve2Serve, let us learn from the life of Moses on why he served God despite of his abilities and life circumstances. His story is obvious, when Moses`mother cannot hid him anymore,(because of the command of the king of Egypt to kill the child if its boy on birth) Exodus 1:16 she put him on a basket then set it by the bank of the Nile. The Pharaoh's daughter took Moses from the river. Moses was nursed by the time he grew up and was returned to Pharaoh's daughter. One day, Moses saw an Egyptian beating up a Hebrew, and he killed the Egyptian. Pharaoh knew what had happened and tried to kill Moses but Moses fled from Egypt to Midian.
