WALK WITH ME:On Mission Together

ICE BREAKER QUESTIONS

- 1. Do you have friendships that have lasted for years? How do you think that happened?
- 2. Who are the people you draw confidence from? Share an instance showing this.

WORD

As we end our series entitled "Walk With Me," we will learn that Peter and the other disciples experienced Christ's ministry first (ie. Luke 5:1-11) before they were commissioned to witness for Him together. We are not only recipients of His grace but also witnesses of his grace into the world.

Walk with me, is an invitation to include someone in your life. It is a call to journey through life with someone unhurriedly, willingly, and joyfully. This is a picture of relational discipleship and it perfectly demonstrates on how Jesus shared life and mission with his disciples.

Walk With Me means;

- Walk is a symbolic of lifestyle. On how we live our life.
- With is our relationship with him first then to others.
- <u>Me</u> is Jesus, our walk with Christ Jesus as he called us by God's grace has a great purpose.

Luke 24:44-49 (ESV)

44 Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled." 45 Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures, 46 and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, 47 and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. 48 You are witnesses of these things. 49

And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

*He reveal God's word. Luke 24:45–46 45 Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures, 46and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead . . ."

We receive revelation and understanding from God's word through consistent devotion, worship, listening to His word during worship service, prayer, through Life groups, etc...

DISCUSSION

How has receiving and understanding God's word changed your life?

WORD

*We are messenger of God's word. Luke 24:47–48 and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. 48 You are witnesses of these things."

We who have been forgiven, reconciled to Him, and restored have been given this special privilege to extend this grace to others. And we do this not merely out of obligation, but because the love of Christ compels us to share who He is to those we love and care about and even to the rest of the world.

*He cloth us with power. Luke 24:49 "And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

The Holy Spirit dwells in the people God set apart for Himself as our assurance and empowerment in doing the mission. He called us to do this together. Through the Holy Spirit's presence in our lives, we are able to be His messengers and witnesses to the world.

DISCUSSION

What might be some obstacles you encounter in sharing the gospel? What practical steps can you take to overcome the struggle?

LIFE APPLICATION

Jesus calls us to proclaim who He is and what He has done to the world. Let us proclaim the good news .We do this by starting to share our 2 minute miracle with our friends, family and colleagues. We do one2one when we build the relationship with others and we can use the tool one2one booklet or app as you see fit when you build that relationship with others.

God cares for the lost and we are the only being that will spread the gospel, there's no other but us and He empower us to *go,grow and glow* as we do these. We will not be alone. We have the Holy Spirit.

Let us not isolate and put God in the box, let us proclaim Him.Let Him Be Known.

1 Peter 1:2b-3 (NIV)2 ...so that by it you may grow up in your salvation, now that you have tasted that the Lord is good.

And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
